### KRASDALE GALLERY

"An Historical Chronicle — The Life of the European Jew in the 20th Century," curated by Sigmund Balka, features photographs by Russian born-photographer Roman Vishniac. In addition to Vishniac's work of Eastern and Central European shtetl life before the Second World War, which made him famous, "An Historical Chronicle" presents multimedia work by the New York-based artist Aaron Morgan and Croatian-born artist Tamar Hirschl. Their works focus on the Holocaust and Israel.

Balka, vice president of cultural affairs for Krasdale Foods, has this show coming on the heels of a recent exhibit of his private collection at the Hebrew Union College — Jewish Institute of Religion.
